There are also event listings in the magazine in the "Events Corner" section which is typically located towards the back of the magazine. You can also check on the Facebook pages of various VJMC groups as well as calling your nearest VJMC Field Representative. Our two groups in eastern Kansas and western Missouri (located in the Kansas City area) typically have seven events yearly from the beginning of summer to September. I will attach our QR code which you can open on your phone. Both Kansas and Missouri groups work closely together and we call ourselves KC VJMC.

If you are a VJMC member please plan on attending several events yearly. Some events are big, some small, some highly organized, and some are more casual. Plan on getting to know members in your area. You are probably closer to other VJMC members than you think.
